Hello Members!

It is hard to believe another year has gone by, but here we are coming into 2022! What an amazing and busy year 2021 has been at the Wells Ogunquit Senior Center. The Board of Directors began the year not knowing if COVID was going to continue to be a problem in 2021, and how we could prepare our budget to keep us moving forward (and pay our bills) in such an uncertain environment. As well, the safety of all our members, staff and guests was a continued factor to keep our programs, services, functions, fundraising and our facility funded in a healthy and happy environment.

A proposed budget based on using a combination of income and expense guidelines from the year *before* COVID and the year *of* COVID, as a mixed goal of growth with caution, was created and passed by the Board. Our Budget for 2021 was the projected total cost/expenses of \$153,500 and a proposed total income goal of \$154,900. Our means to attain our income goals included several recently tried successes... the four "Fairs"... a new adventure, a very successful Golf Tournament, and reliable successes such as Bingo (our top income event), the Pancake Breakfasts, 100 Club Raffles, Clynk, a fundraising bulk mailing, and a come-back out of the past - our annual Fashion Show. We also need to acknowledge our community supporters like the Varano Family, with their three hosted fundraisers, and the many, many businesses who contribute to our Senior Center.

It is with pride and pleasure the Board announces that we not only met our budgeted income goal, but surpassed it with a total accumulated income to date (with one week left in December) of \$158,966 brought in this year of 2021!!! Our expenses will likely be about \$157,000 - meaning we held our costs to be less than our income and we will end in the black for 2021 and right on target with our budget!!!

In this topsy-turvy last two years, the Center could not have been as successful without the strength, support and help of our Members, our Staff, our Board and our Community. We are indeed Blessed.

Thank you all for a terrific 2021, and the Board looks forward to serving you in 2022.
