Greetings from the Board of Directors!

First:

November reminds us that with Veterans Day comes a well deserved day of recognition and thanks for those who have served our country in the Military. Their sacrifices and willingness to fight for the freedoms we all so wonderfully enjoy is deeply appreciated by all in America, in our State, in our Town and in our Membership in this organization.

We salute those Members who are Veterans and thank God everyday for your service.

Second:

Several people have asked me why the Town does not give us money to help run our Center. Last month I explained that we are an independent non-profit 501c3 organization and we are responsible for our finances — the Town is not financially responsible for us.

However, I want members to know that we DO receive a substantial benefit from our Town and the taxpayers here in Wells. We do not pay property tax to the Town. As a 501c3 we filed an exemption from property tax when we first opened, which is allowed under Maine State law, and can approved by the Town — the Town approved it.

Our property taxes, if fully valued, would run between \$6000-\$8000 a year. Each year, we receive this benefit which is a shared cost by all the Taxpayers in Wells. We also can - and just did - receive a \$3000 Grant from the Town of Wells. We applied for it last year to receive it for this year and it arrived Tuesday. Also, I am proud to have you know that the Wells Town Hall Staff, the Fire Department, and the Police Department have each hosted a "Days of Warming" on Saturdays for the last several years — making and serving a meal for our members who attend.

Since November is the month of Thanksgiving, I ask our Members along with our Board to give thanks to our Veterans and to the Town of Wells and it's community.
