Maine is currently under another round of COVID-19 increases, and restrictions in mask wearing, social distancing and limited numbers in gatherings. The Board wants you all to know that we and our staff are continuing to follow all the necessary precautions to allow our Center to be safe and still accessible to our membership. Our Covid-19 rules are posted inside the Center and on our outside doors. You can also ask Rita or Cathy to provide you our guidelines.

We are *reminding* our members and visitors to follow the rules for entering our building with masks, wearing them while moving around within the Center (including activities), sanitizing hands, and to sign in and provide contact information upon entering. The Board is pleased to announce to our membership that we have received a Maine Economic Recovery Grant for \$17,443.53 based on approximately 90% of our lost income due to Covid-19 shutdowns and restrictions that negatively impacted our ability to raise normal funding. The application was filed nearly two months ago. We should be receiving the check the week after Thanksgiving. Because of all the members' and volunteers' hard work, dedication and commitment this harsh year in our herculean fundraising efforts—PLUS the grant monies - we have kept the Center open and running. We have had to use some of our savings to pay bills, but this grant will soften those losses. **Thank you Volunteers and BAKERS!**
