COVID 19 2021 SUGGESTED RULES

Days of Warming Safety Guidelines

- One entrance in (front door) and ONE exit (back door in function room) (If handicap person requires front door, worker/volunteer escort guest out door PLEASE)
- **Masks required to enter building**
- **SIGN IN** upon entering and sanitize hands
- **Maximum of 50 people in BUILDING**
- **Maximum of 40 people to be signed up to eat as guests only.** First come first served sign up. If NOT on sign up list can not be allowed in building as lunch guest.
- **Maximum of 10 to cook, serve, work or entertain**
- Entertainer, workers, servers or cooks must wear masks while in building unless sitting eating.
- **Masks worn in building at all times unless sitting at table.**
- **If you leave table, MASKS must be worn & hands must be sanitized BEFORE returning to table.**
- **Tables will socially distanced apart and set up for 50 people to account for workers, entertainers or servers planning to eat as well as 40 “guests”.**

NOTE: Entertainment will be set up in function room. Singers must be 12 feet socially distanced or wear mask. Musicians, not singing should wear masks. Microphone must be sanitized before putting away, or have protective covering.

NOTE: Meal providers/servers/workers prepare and clean up area.

Tables sanitized end of day, unless vacated earlier.

*If you are not feeling well or have health concerns about coming to our events, please do not attend. YOUR safety and comfort are our concerns, too.

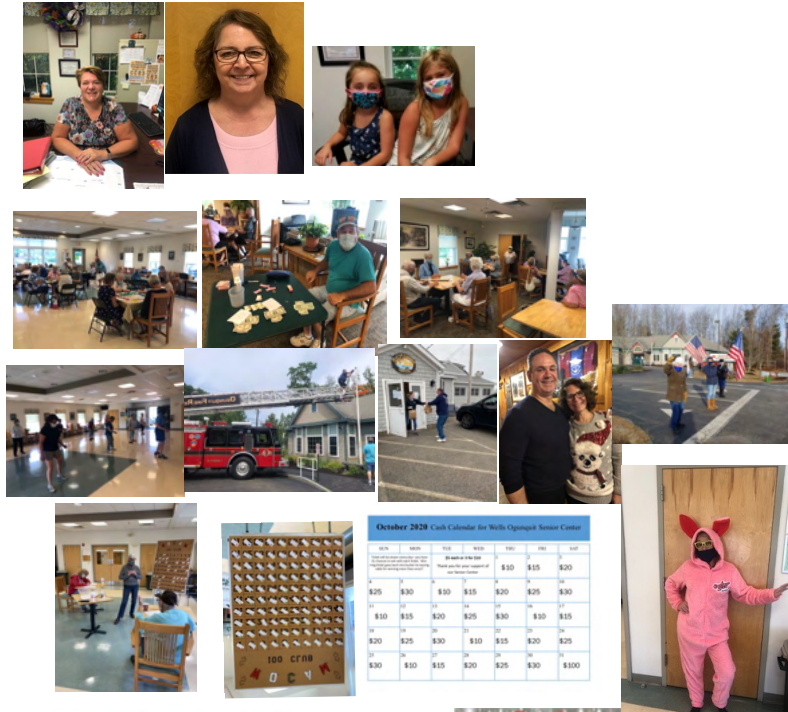
*Should auld acquaintance be forgot,
